

Ringmore Neighbourhood Plan Steering Group

Minutes of meeting Tuesday 24th March 2020, 7.00pm, by Video Conference

The meeting was held via a video conferencing link due to the Covid 19 outbreak and government regulations regarding social distancing.

2. The Minutes of the meeting on the 22nd January 2020 were accepted as a true record.
3. Nancy Singleton, a new resident in the village with previous experience of Parish Council and Parish plans elsewhere had been asked to give the proposed report a first proof reading and gave her response.

Overall she felt the Draft Plan had been a very good effort by the team involved.

She felt that the "Vision Statement" as it stood should be more aspirational.

Also statements about "traffic" should have more emphasis.

Business Consultations should include the Holywell Stores although this was not in the Parish and would be difficult during the Covid 19 outbreak.

4. After discussion, it was resolved to modify the Vision Statement and MC would circulate a draft.
MC would review references to "traffic" in the draft Plan.
5. There had been business consultations with Mr Tucker (Farmer), Mr Hext (Farmer) and Bigbury Holiday Park. Reports on these meetings had been circulated and would be incorporated into the appendices of the Plan and MF would consider if there were any implications to either the Tourism Section or Business Sections of the draft Plan.
6. It was agreed that after updates following this meeting the draft Plan would be sent to Val Scott, a qualified town planning consultant and also chair of Bigbury NP Steering Group, for a critical proof reading.
