

What is a Neighbourhood Plan

An NPP is a community-led tool for guiding the future of an area. It is about the use and development of land and can include ideas and proposals for future developments.

A NPP will be part of the **Statutory Development Plan** or **Local Plan (LDP)** for the area. This gives an NPP the same weight other planning documents have.

The LDP is the statutory planning framework under which all new build development in the South Hams, Plymouth and Devon Coast areas must comply. The LDP places broad policy directives which are refined at local level by the Neighbourhood plans. Among other things it identifies the approximate number of houses that should be built over approximately the next 20 years in each community.

An NPP must comply with national legislation. The LDP and contributes to sustainable development. It can specify on how future development may be designed and located.

The production of an NPP requires community involvement at every stage of the process and finally the Parish will have a vote on whether to accept the plan.



Why does Ringmore Parish need a Neighbourhood Plan?

Ringmore Parish Council has indicated the Ringmore Neighbourhood Plan.

1. The PC is promoting the NPP because it gives your Parish a stronger voice than was previously available to us.
2. The NPP enables communities to take the lead and gives them influence and more control over planning the future of Ringmore Parish - it will have real local focus.
3. The plan can also guide infrastructure development in dealing with problems e.g. traffic, sewage, electricity supply.
4. The plan is also a key document in improving the "sustainability" of an area.
5. The NPP will allow Ringmore Parish to influence the location, type and size of future housing and help to protect other areas from development.
6. The draft Local Plan (LDP) currently states that Ringmore can accommodate 10 houses initially*. The NPP is the Parish's way of guiding this process. (*This clause in the LDP is currently under review).

7. The NPP can be a way to address the subject of second home ownership for new houses.
e.g. The Rivers model.

8. Any area that does not have a Neighbourhood Plan has limited control over future housing developments.

Your Thoughts and Ideas Matter

This is only the first step and there will be further public consultations before the plan is finalised.


