In contrast, another D&M member was permitted to speak and vote in spite of his declared view before the debate began. RPC and MsP believed this deprived Ringmore of representation. It was also was noted that since the September D&M meeting, details of previous applications have now been removed from the SHDC Planning Portal thus not allowing a full history of this application to be read.

RPC will protest these issues formally to SHDC.
